Subject: Memorandum of Understanding\Radios

To: All Concerned

Management and Local 709 have mutually agreed that to ensure the safety of all staff effective June 4, 2006, **all** staff (management and line staff, no exceptions) reporting for work will be required to carry a radio during their tour of duty. To assist staff with the transition it is recommended that staff carry a radio during their tour of duty to get used to carrying a radio prior to the effective date.

Additionally, radios will no longer be assigned to specific job titles but rather by number and will be available to all staff. However, the radios with body alarms, keypads, and channel nine (9) will continue to be assigned to the specific job title. Should you have difficulty in checking out a radio or if radios are unavailable, notify the Captain, either Associate Warden, or your supervisor. This Memorandum of Understanding supersedes any previous Memorandum of Understanding.
